

## 2020 is the 65<sup>th</sup> Year of the current Hancock County 4-H Agricultural Association

► The Hancock County 4-H Agricultural Association, Inc. was established on August 7, 1945. We are a non-stock, non-profit sharing organization who's responsible for securing adequate finances for the 4-H programs and various phases of the 4-H county fair. In 1945: Keith Elsbury was President, John Thomas, Vice-President, Elaine Edwards, Secretary and Glen Boyd was Treasurer. Also active in the group was Norman Cook, Mrs. Ed Kleiman, Mrs. Russel Cushman, Earl Downen and Shirley Lakin.

# 2021 will the 165 years since the 1<sup>st</sup> Hancock County Fair and the 1<sup>st</sup> Ag Association

- The first agricultural association of which we have any definite history was organized in the county in 1856, for the purpose of holding county fairs. The first county fair was held during the summer of 1856 at the east end of town, on the north side of the National Road. A. T. Hart was the first president.
- In 1857 it was moved to the south side of the railroad, east of Brandywine Creek, on land belonging to Samuel Milroy.
- Not every year saw a fair. War, lack of funds and location
