

# Know Before You Go

## Hancock County 2020

### NOT A PUBLIC FAIR

The fair is not open to the public in 2020. It is for 4-H project exhibition only. 4-H issued bracelets must be worn for entrance to the fairgrounds. Entrance gates are located off of Apple Street and Park Street, Please use the South entrance off of Apple Street to visit the Exhibit Hall and use the West Gate entrance off of Park Street for all livestock exhibits.

### WEBCAST

Great News! The Hancock County Fair exhibits will be live for all to see! Stay tuned to watch projects live on Show Barn Flix. Those who are unable to attend in person can enjoy in the comfort of their home or on any device with access to wifi.

### ENTRY

Each 4-H exhibitor will receive 5 bracelets per livestock project and 5 total for all Exhibit Hall projects. Each bracelet will be "Day" specific with the exception of the Exhibit Hall. Exhibit Hall bracelets will allow access Saturday-Thursday. Your bracelet will allow access to the event areas of your project. For example, Exhibit Hall bracelet will allow access to enjoy the Exhibit Hall only on the grounds. If you have a swine bracelet, you will be able to access all barns, and people spaces on Sunday.

### SHOW AND GO

All livestock will arrive on the same day as the show. Livestock can depart from exit locations when they are complete with their day at any time on their individual show day. It is important to note your specific project arrival time, check in deadline and show start time.

### SOCIAL DISTANCING

Social Distancing is important. You will need to follow signage as posted on the fairgrounds. Face coverings are to be worn when social distancing cannot be met. 6ft indicators will be marked easily for exhibitor reference.

### NO FIT SHOW

The fair is "No Fit Show" for livestock which is defined by no glue, adhesive or paint.  
No clipping or shearing at the fair. Sheens, and aerosols welcome.

### HAND SANITIZING AND DISINFECTING

Hand Sanitizer and disinfectant cleaning kits will be throughout the fairgrounds for exhibitor use and exhibitor guest use.

### RESTROOMS

Restrooms and Portable Restrooms will be available at the fairgrounds for attendees. Showman, be prepared to know that full restroom space is limited for social distancing. Plan accordingly.

### FOOD AND BEVERAGE

The Ag Association will have the terrific lemonade shake up stand at the fairgrounds. There will not be a carnival nor food vendors. Please plan accordingly.
