### Hancock County Fairgrounds Rules

- No smoking in buildings. Follow Hancock County Tobacco Free Policy - The Hancock County ordinance prohibits smoking in all public places and workplaces including restaurants, bars, outdoor seating areas. We ask that you respect our visitors and families and do not smoke near other guests.
  - No Alcoholic beverages are permitted to be served, consumed or present on the fairgrounds.
    - No firearms or knives, the Hancock County Fairgrounds is PRIVATE PROPERTY.
- No ANIMALS, birds, or reptiles except those participating in a competition or show sanctioned by the fair or licensed service animal. Persons violating this rule will be immediately requested to leave.
  - Not responsible for lost or stolen articles, if you lose an item, please check the sheriff tent or fair office.
    - No unauthorized golf carts/ATV located on fairgrounds.
    - All vehicles parked in non-designated areas or blocking right of ways will be subject to towing.
  - Press passes should be worn and visible by all press/media taking pictures and may be picked up at the Sheriff tent.
    - Report any accidents or damage to the fairgrounds office at 317-462-1469. In case of emergency call 911.
- ALL VOLUNTEERS & EXHIBITORS - DO NOT park around buildings between 8 AM - 10 PM. If you need a gator to haul items from the parking lot, please reach out to a board member.
